


Table 10 Muscles and innervation associated with Component 10 - Epiglottic Movement.




Figure 20 Muscles and innervation of Component 10 - Epiglottic Movement.







- As they take turns reading aloud their lines, focusing on their target sound, they are performing together in the same humorous play.





