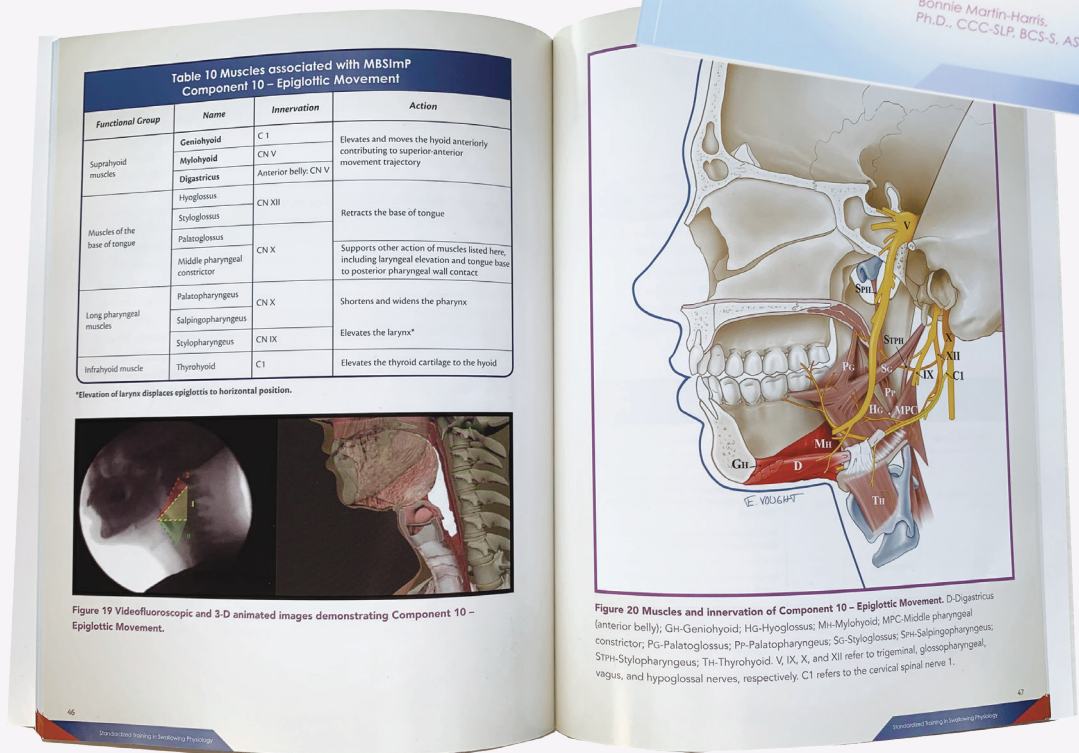

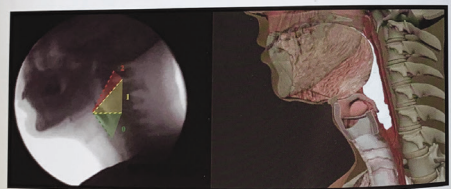


Figure 19 Videofluoroscopic and 3-D animated images demonstrating Component 10 - Epiglottic Movement.

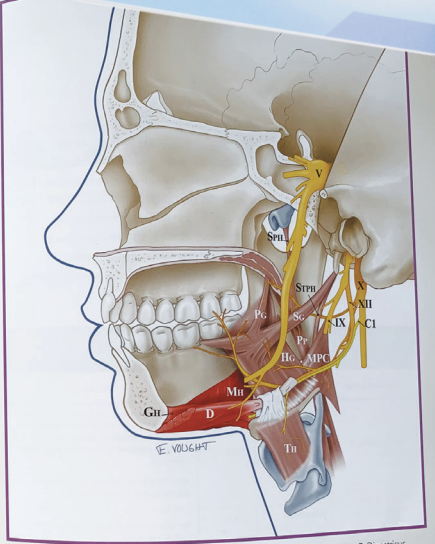


Figure 20 Muscles and innervation of Component 10 - Epiglottic Movement. D-Digastric (anterior belly); GH-Geniohyoid; HG-Hyoglossus; MH-Mylohyoid; MPC-Middle pharyngeal constrictor; PG-Palatoglossus; Pr-Palatopharyngeus; SG-Styloglossus; Sph-Salpingopharyngeus; STPh-Stylopharyngeus; Th-Thyrohyoid. V, IX, X, and XII refer to trigeminal, glossopharyngeal, vagus, and hypoglossal nerves, respectively. C1 refers to the cervical spinal nerve 1.
